  - Research on the theory and application of red beds and Danxia tourism development;
  - The research findings and trends of red beds and Danxia in the world.
- (b) Theory and Practice of Environmental Protection and Utilization of Red Layer and Danxia Landform
  - The environmental problems of red beds and Danxia area such as geological hazards and soil erosion;
  - The evaluation system of resources and environment in red beds and Danxia area;
  - The mechanism of land degradation and desertification in red beds and Danxia area;
  - Environmental protection and ecological restoration in red beds and Danxia area:
  - Resources utilization and sustainable development in red bed area.
- (c) International comparison research and the value of red beds
- (d) Recent work on the Red Beds and Danxia Working Group
- (e) Investigate Danxia landforms such as Yongning Mountain, Maoxiang, Tianshengqiao and then discuss how to scientifically protect and sustainably use the resources.
